

Procedures for BEFA PAE – May 2011

As of April 30, the hangar at PAE that was used by BEFA has been vacated. New procedures for utilizing the airplanes at PAE have been implemented.



N704RY (C-150) and N4801D (C-172) are now located at tie-downs between the old Jet Deck restaurant and the fueling station, across from Regal Air.

Regal Air has kindly allowed BEFA the use of their facilities for flight planning. There is a file cabinet in the Flight Planning room inside Regal for storing pilot records, equipment, oil, etc. You can access the Flight Planning room during Regal's open hours:

Monday – Friday 8am - 8pm
Saturday & Sunday 8am - 5pm

The tach logs, keys, gas cards, and a ladder are located under the awning of the Jet Deck restaurant, just behind the airplanes. Look for a wooden bench with the words "Fly Safely" and you'll find the BEFA white lock box. The lock is keyed to the same keys that all PAE pilots already have for the old hangar lock box.

The white lock box is a temporary solution. In the near future, Regal will install a combination lock to the outside of the Flight Planning room so it is accessible 24 x 7. After the Flight Planning Room is available from the outside, the white lock box will be retired, and the tach logs, keys, and the ladder will be located in the Flight Planning Room. An email will be sent out when this happens.

There are many benefits to the new operations at PAE, namely the use of Regal's wonderful facilities, and the close proximity of the planes to the fuel station. Please make every courtesy when you are in Regal, and express your gratitude and appreciation for their generosity as often as possible!
